Dear Mr. Jackson,

I reviewed the letter and associated documentation you sent to the Elyria Highway Patrol Post regarding your traffic stop and subsequent arrest by Trooper C.H. Beyer on June 14, 2011. Since receiving your letter I have also been informed your criminal arrest through the Lorain County Common Pleas Court has been adjudicated.

The specific allegations that Trooper Beyer 'knowingly and willfully falsified documents' and 'committed perjury under oath' are unfounded. Further concerns should be directed to the Lorain County Common Pleas Court and handled through any potential appeals process.

The allegations that Trooper Beyer aided another officer to violate a rule, abused authority, lacked courtesy, etc. are unfounded. Trooper Beyer conducted your traffic stop within the guidelines established by the policies and procedures and rules and regulations of the Ohio State Highway Patrol.

Also please know that LEADS information can only be used for criminal justice purposes and for the administration of criminal justice under state and federal law. Please refer to OAC 4510:2-10-06, ORC 2913.04 and 28 CFR 20.33. These records are not subject to release, and therefore, I cannot provide them to you.

My office considers your misconduct allegations to be unfounded. Please direct all court related matters to the Lorain County Common Pleas Court.
