To see if any of them can assist you, you will need to communicate directly with them.

If you believe that a judge or lawyer has acted unethically, then you have a right to file a grievance against that judge or lawyer. We are enclosing two forms which you may use to file such a grievance with the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, if that is your desire, as well as some information on the grievance process. Please note that the forms are to be returned to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, and not to the Ohio State Bar Association.

Since the Ohio State Bar Association is unable to assist you, we are returning your letter and its enclosures.
