
Dear Mr. Jackson:

The following points are in response to your letter dated October 4, 2012.

1. I have never ignored either directly or indirectly any of your correspondence. I have read all of your correspondence and have made all proper legal arguments to the Court under Ohio Law.
2. We have had several Pre-trials and hearings since August 15, 2012 and I was always available to discuss any issues you have with my representation of you.
